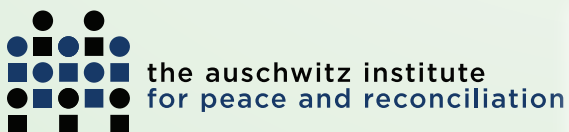
Historical memory contributes to the formation of individual and group identities. In this workshop, participants will explore how traumatic historical events are remembered and memorialized by considering essential questions such as:
